

THE EXCEPTIONALLY FAVORABLE AND SPECIFIC NATURAL AND CLIMATIC CONDITIONS OF THE BAY WERE DECISIVE FACTORS FOR THE EARLY SETTLING OF THE AREA. THIS LED TO THE FORMATION OF TOWNS AND SETTLEMENTS IN A DISTINCTIVE WAY, CREATING A UNIQUE HARMONY OF THE WORKS OF NATURE AND HUMAN SPIRIT.

\$INCE 1997, THE BAY OF BOKA KOTORSKA HAS BEEN A PART OF THE ASSOCIATION OF TWENTY-FIVE THE MOST BEAUTIFUL BAYS IN THE WORLD.

SITUATED IN ONE OF THE MOST BEAUTIFUL BAYS IN THE WORLD, KOTOR, THE TOWN OF TRADERS AND FAMOUS SEAMEN, HAS A LOT TO TELL. THE OLD TOWN OF KOTOR IS THE BEST-PRESERVED URBAN CENTRE FROM THE MIDDLE AGES, TYPICAL FOR THE TOWNS THAT WERE CREATED IN THE 12TH AND 14TH CENTURIES. THE MEDIEVAL ARCHITECTURE AND NUMEROUS MONUMENTS OF THIS CULTURAL HERITAGE HAVE PUT KOTOR ON THE UNESCO LIST OF THE "World Natural and Cultural Heritage Sites". Throughout the city there are STRUCTURES, INTERWOVEN BY STREETS AND SQUARES. THE OLD NARROW STREETS, ROMANTIC BARS AND RESTAURANTS, SMALL SHOPS, ANTIQUE MONUMENTS, CHURCHES AND PICTURESQUE BUILDINGS, CARNIVALS AND FEASTS ORGANISED EACH YEAR GIVE AN ADDITIONAL CHARM TO THE MOST BEAUTIFUL CITY ON THE MONTENEGRIN COAST. FROM 1420 TO 1797 KOTOR WAS PART OF VENICE AND ITS ARCHITECTURAL INFLUENCE CAN BE SEEN ON THE CITY'S ARCHITECTURE. KOTOR IS ONE OF THE BEST-PRESERVED ANCIENT CITIES AND FORTRESSES IN THE ADRIATIC SEA. ITS WALLS, BUILT THROUGH CENTURIES, ARE APPROXIMATELY 4.5 KM LONG. AT 260M ABOVE SEA LEVEL IS THE TOP OF THE WALLS, THE SAN GIOVANNI FORTRESS. ST ANNE'S CHURCH, THE ROMANESQUE CHURCH DATES FROM THE END OF THE XII CENTURY AND HAS FRESCOES DATING BACK FROM XV CENTURY. THERE ARE THE OTHER OLD CHURCHES AS ST. LUKE, ST. TRYPHON, ST. NICHOLAS, OLD TOWN THEATER CALLED NAPOLEON'S, THE MARITIME MUSEUM AND NUMEROUS PALACES BLENDING OF DIFFERENT, ESPECIALLY ROMANESQUE AND BAROQUE STYLES.
